-  Sweet chestnut coppice (Ancient replanted woodland)
-  Conifer plantation (mostly Scot's pine) (Ancient replanted woodland or PAWS)
-  Mixed broadleaves (Ancient semi-natural woodland)
-  Failed plantation / wood pasture / wooded heath
-  Birch (Ancient semi-natural woodland)
-  Beech (Ancient semi-natural woodland)
-  Extensive rhododendron colonisation
This introduced non-native species is very invasive and suppresses native ground flora, reducing biodiversity
-  Stream/wet area
-  Private landowner
